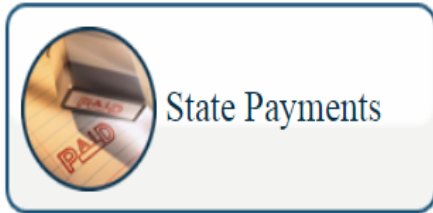


ROADMAP TO FOLLOW THE MONEY

Florida's Transparency website, <https://www.myfloridacfo.com/Transparency/>, was created to ensure accountability, and allow Floridians to see how money is spent. This website provides information for state budgets, payments and contracts.

State Payments

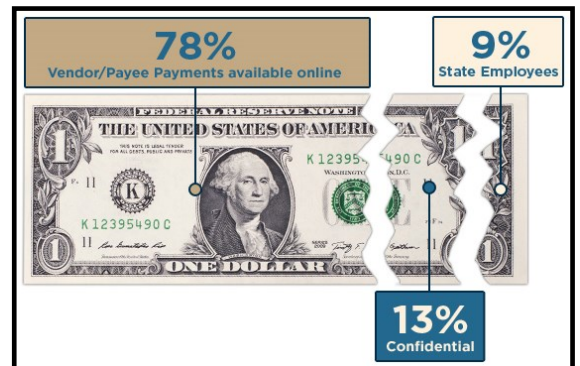


For contract or payment information, including contracts, payments to vendors, and state employee salaries, click on the State Payments tile. The payment information comes from the State's accounting system (FLAIR), and the salary information is provided by the Department of Management Services and Florida's 12 State Universities.

Vendor/Payee Payment

Search **Vendor/Payee Payments** by clicking on the Vendor/Payee icon. Searches can be completed by:

- Vendor Name
- Time Period
- Paying Agency(s)
- Object Code Classification(s) for payments such as travel, independent contractors etc.



Downloads: To view downloads by fiscal year, click on the link in the download area. The file can be saved for future viewing. You have the ability to download vendor payments by fiscal year (2009-2016).

State Employee Salary Information

Search **State Employee Information** by clicking on the State Employees icon. You can search by both pensions and State payrolls.


FACTS

Quasi-Public Agencies




Quasi-Public Agencies are created for a specific function at a State or local level, but are organizationally separate from the primary government. They may be partially or fully funded by the government and are accountable to the primary government. Local-level Quasi-Public Agencies submit annual financial reports related to revenue and expenditure data through the Local Government Electronic Reporting (LOGER) system. Applicable State-level Quasi-Public Agencies are included in the State's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report as component units.

To **Create/Run** Revenue or Expenditure reports, click on the Quasi Government Spending tile.

Downloadable Data is available for revenue and expenditure reports by year.
